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# INTRODUCTION

The **Christmas Tree Jubilee** is a family event that is filled with Christmas fun, including ornament craft-making stations and activities, as well as a large group teaching and worship experience. These activities and experiences will take kids on a journey through the family tree of Jesus from the Old Testament to the birth of Jesus in the New Testament. This event includes everything you need to host the event: graphics, promotional materials, a teaching video, a supply list, volunteer roles, decorating tips, and more!

## How to Use the Event

The **Christmas Tree Jubilee** could be used any time during the Advent season. It can be paired with the Jesus Family Tree Christmas weekly series or used on its own. You could use this event on the first day of Advent to kick off the Jesus Family Tree series. You could also use it during Christmastime as a stand-alone event.

- **ALL-CHURCH EVENT.** Invite your entire church to be a part of this event during the month of December, before or after church, or as an evening or weekend event!
- **FAMILY EVENT.** Host the event for kids and families who attend your church. This is a great connection tool for parents, and also a way to equip families as they lead their kids.
- **COMMUNITY OUTREACH EVENT.** In addition to those who already attend your church, invite families from the community to join the fun and meet new friends. Make sure to follow up and thank new families for coming!
- **ALL-CHURCH CHRISTMAS DECORATING EVENT.** When it's time to decorate your church for Christmas, this event can kick off your decorating time! Start with the event and transition into a time of decorating. Intentionally crafted to include and engage people of all ages.
- **KIDS-ONLY EVENT.** Offer the event during your midweek kid's service or on a Sunday morning or evening in December. Using it on the first Sunday of Advent would be a great way to kick off the Wonder Ink Jesus Family Tree series.
